- 1. The meeting of the Paso del Norte Watershed Council was called to order by Conrad Keyes at 3:05 PM. Quorum present. Everyone introduced themselves and the agenda was approved.
- 2. Decisions
 - a. Minutes of the Annual Meeting held Dec 10, 2015 were approved with a few corrections to names. The final version will be posted on the website.
 - b. Election of officers: Nominees: Asst Chair—Jan Kirwan, Secretary—Sue Watts, Treasurer—Ari Michelsen. All were elected by acclamation.
- 3. Stormwater letter—The original draft of the letter has been highly edited and many felt it was now too vague and/or that their agencies would not support it. Decision was to table a vote until a revised draft is available.
- 4. PdNWC Workplan 2016-2020: review 2015-2019 plan and send proposed amendments to Conrad. Look at personnel and objectives/actions.
- 5. Reports and co-chair updates:
 - a. PdNWC Financial Report-Ari Michelsen. No changes since last report. Task order 1 being reviewed by TAMU which includes website maintenance and a fish study. Chris Brown is PI for both. Will require a professional services agreement between Brown and Bixby (SWEC) for fish study.
 - b. Technical Committee Report-Zhuping Sheng. RiverWare model linked from headwaters to El Paso/Hudspeth County line. Stakeholder meetings have been held. A choice of models are available including ag, urban, and economic factors. Environmental factors not as well-defined. The Tech Committee will review the PdNWC workplan.

- c. Biological Committee-Kevin Bixby/Brian Hanson. Minutes from the last meeting are complete. Brian will continue as co-chair with Gill. Liz, Jan, Mike G. volunteered to be on the committee. Other interested parties should email Brian. Liz reported that a revised draft for stakeholder review of the remaining portions of the IBWC river management plan will be completed by late spring 2016.
- d. Website update-Chris Brown. Liz will be point of contact, replacing Hilary. Requests for changes to the website should be directed to Liz and she will forward.
- e. Clean Water Committee—Leslie Grijalva. It was proposed that the Clean Water Committee combine with the Biological Committee to form an Environmental Committee. 9 votes for; 1 vote against.
- 6. New business/announcements. Desert Land Conservation Cooperative will meet in Alpine Feb 1-5.
